



How students evaluated I-WEEK 2025?

Within the framework of International Week 2025, we conducted a survey among students to get feedback on the I-WEEK. Below are the main conclusions from their responses:

Most of the students rated the quality of the course content very positively, with many courses receiving a rating of 4 or 5 (the best rating).

How would you rate the quality of the course content?



Ratings of the intensity of the courses varied, with some students rating the courses as very intensive (rating 5), while others rated them less intensive (rating 2 or 3).

How would you rate the intensity of the course (time intensity, length of individual blocks)?



Many students described the guest teachers as inspiring, motivating and well prepared. The teachers received special mention for their ability to explain complex topics clearly and keep students' interest. Some students mentioned that some teachers could improve their preparation and organization, especially for online courses. But here we would stand up for the professors who had online courses, because the transfer of the courses took place a few days before the I-WEEK due to the medical indisposition of the teachers. On the other hand, we were very glad that the professors agreed to this option and we didn't have to cancel the courses.






How would you describe the guest teacher's approach during the lesson?



Students appreciated the courses that included practical examples, interactive activities and clear explanations. Courses that were purely lecture-based with no activities received lower ratings. Very appreciated was the opportunity to learn from visiting teachers from other countries.



A significant number of students attended the courses to obtain 3 ECTS credits. Many students also registered because of their interest in the specific topics offered and, lastly, improving professional knowledge and personal development were also frequent reasons for attending.



Students suggested offering more courses on topics such as AI, cybersecurity, blockchain and other modern technologies. Requests for more practical examples and hands-on courses were also mentioned.





What topics should we offer next year?



Overall, students expressed gratitude for this initiative and the opportunity to participate in International Week. Some students provided feedback on specific aspects of the courses that could be improved, such as clearer instructions for grading and better communication about course logistics.
