

How the visiting professors evaluated I-WEEK 2025

During International Week 2025, we surveyed visiting professors to get feedback on the organisation and running of the event. Below are the main conclusions from their responses:

Most professors rated the preparation and organization of the courses very positively. In particular, they appreciated the effective communication and support from the coordinators both before their arrival and during the visit itself.

How do you rate the communication and support from the coordinators before and during your visit?



Visiting professors highlighted the active involvement of students during the teaching. Students were motivated and engaged, which contributed to the dynamism of the courses. They considered the optimal classroom group size to be between 20 and 40 students, depending on the type of course and space availability. Some of the respondents would have liked to see the daily schedule shortened to six hours, with the last day reserved for the final meeting as planned originally.

How would you rate student engagement during the class?

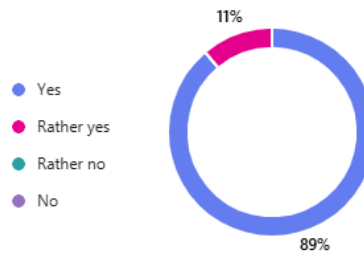
