

Support programme "Support for Dissertation Research"

The main objective of the programme is to support full-time FIS PhD students to fully focus on addressing their dissertation research questions during their PhD studies. Another aim of the programme is to motivate students to successfully complete their PhD studies within the standard study period.

Project duration: maximum six months. A PhD student may receive support from this programme repeatedly during the standard period of PhD studies at FIS.

Deadline and method of submission: by 24 March 2025 at 12 PM to the FIS Dean's Office in a sealed envelope marked "Support for Dissertation Research".

Requirements for applicants

- A doctoral student is a full-time student of FIS during the standard period of doctoral studies.

Application requirements for the programme:

- The project contains a description of the activities that the applicant intends to carry out within the project. The activities are accompanied by a timetable for the solution, which is divided into two stages. The estimated length is 4-5 A4 pages.

Funding:

Extraordinary scholarship in the amount of 10.000,- CZK per month.

Selection of candidates:

- The submitted projects, recommended by the supervisor, will be evaluated by a committee appointed by the Dean.

Control of project implementation:

Checks will be carried out at the mid-point (after about three months of the project) and at the end of the project. The Commission may suggest on the basis of the results of the control an adjustment of the amount of the scholarship of the ongoing project.
