

Regulation
by the Dean of the Faculty of Informatics and Statistics
No. 08/2018 from 11th June 2018
on granting scholarships for academic year 2018/2019

The Dean of the Faculty of Informatics and Statistics (hereafter as the “Faculty”) hereby determines the conditions for granting scholarships to students at the Faculty, in accordance with the Scholarship Regulations of the University of Economics, Prague.

Article 1

Merit Scholarship

1. Merit scholarship for excellent study results pursuant to Article 3 of the Scholarship Regulations of the University of Economics, Prague, may be awarded to a student in the *bachelor study* at the Faculty who:
 - a) Study in their 3rd to 6th semester,
 - b) Achieved an average grade of 1.50 inclusive in academic year 2017/2018, and
 - c) Gained at least 60 compliance credits in academic year 2017/2018.

2. Merit scholarship for excellent study results pursuant to Article 3 of the Scholarship Regulations of the University of Economics, Prague, may be awarded to a student in the *master study* at the Faculty who:
 - a) Study in their 3rd or 4th semester,
 - b) Achieved an average grade of 1.50 inclusive in academic year 2017/2018, and
 - c) Gained at least 60 compliance credits in academic year 2017/2018.

3. Merit scholarship for excellent study results pursuant to Article 3 of the Scholarship Regulations of the University of Economics, Prague, may be awarded to a student in the 1st semester of the *master study* at the Faculty who graduated with honours from their bachelor study at the University of Economics in academic year 2016/2017.

Article 2

Extraordinary Scholarship

1. Extraordinary scholarship may be awarded to a student by the Dean in the cases determined in Art. 4 of the Scholarship Regulations of the University of Economics, Prague.

2. Extraordinary scholarship may be awarded to a student in his or her 1st year of bachelor study who, in academic year 2017/2018:
 - a. Achieved at least the percentile of 90 in the test of general study prerequisites in the National Comparative Exams, or

- b. Took part in the national level of a contest recorded by the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports¹ in the list of contests and shows in the category “Contest A and B”, and were placed among the top three, or
 - c. Completed the optional part of the secondary school graduation called Mathematics+ and scored a grade of *excellent* or *very good*,and at the same time:
 - d. gained at least 29 compliance credits in the first semester, and
 - e. gained at least 57 compliance credits in the first two semesters combined.
3. Extraordinary scholarship may be awarded to a student in especially difficult social circumstances.

Article 3

Average Grade

The average grade is calculated pursuant to Article 3, letter g) of the Study and Examination Regulations of the University of Economics, Prague.

Article 4

Scholarship Request

1. A student applies for the merit scholarship by means of an electronic request in the InSIS information system.
2. The request for granting the merit scholarship pursuant to Article 1, par. 1 and 2 shall include:
 - a. The following formulation: “I request to be granted the merit scholarship pursuant to Article 1 of the Regulation by the Dean of the Faculty of Informatics and Statistics No. 08/2018”,
 - b. The average grade for academic year 2017/2018 rounded to two decimal places, and
 - c. The number of gained compliance credits for academic year 2017/2018.
3. The request for granting the merit scholarship pursuant to Article 1, par. 3 shall include:
 - a. The following formulation: “I request to be granted the merit scholarship pursuant to Article 1 of the Regulation by the Dean of the Faculty of Informatics and Statistics No. 08/2018”, and
 - b. Substantiation of the request.
4. The request for granting the extraordinary scholarship shall include:
 - a. The following formulation: “I request to be granted the extraordinary pursuant to Article 2 of the Regulation by the Dean of the Faculty of Informatics and Statistics No. 08/208, and

- b. Substation of the request; in the case of a request pursuant to Article 2, par. 2, applicable materials shall be included as well.
5. The deadline for submitting a request for the merit scholarship pursuant to Article 1, and the extraordinary scholarship pursuant to Article 2, par. 2, is 30th September 2018.
6. The extraordinary scholarship pursuant to Article 2, par. 1 and 3 may be awarded at any time during the academic year.

Article 5

Awarding Scholarship

The Dean decides on granting the scholarship based on the proposal presented by the Scholarship Committee of the Faculty.

Article 6

Amount of Scholarship

The amount granted in the scholarship depends on the available funds of the Faculty and the number of applicants.

Article 7

Scholarship Payment

1. The merit scholarship is paid in monthly instalments and may be paid retrospectively for October, November and December.
2. A student is not entitled to the merit scholarship for the months of July and August.
3. The extraordinary scholarship pursuant to Article 2, par. 1 and 3 is paid in a single payment.
4. The extraordinary scholarship pursuant to Article 2, par. 2 is paid in two instalments upon fulfilling the condition pursuant to Article 2, par. 2, letter d) and e).

Article 8

This Regulation becomes valid on 11th June 2018 and comes into force on 1st July 2018.
