

Information on the Minor State Exam in Economic Data Analysis

The minor state exams consists of two parts:

- 1) Writing of the Project
- 2) Defend of the Project

1) How to write the PROJECT:

The Final State Exam in Economic Data Analysis includes a project where:

- The author will find some data source which he will analyse.
- The author has to apply some of the methods from statistical or econometric courses.
- The length of the analysis should be up to 20-25 pages with classical structure (see Project template).
- The author should choose a consultant for his/her project.

The author should apply simple statistical or econometric methods on economic data, use simple statistical or econometric software and demonstrate his/her ability to use those methods.

If the student passed the course 4ES526, he would not submit the same project for 4ES526 and the Final State Exam.

2) DEFEND of the Project:

- The presentation (defend) should be up to 15min.
- Discussion at the Final State Exam will be focused both on the project and on the theoretical issues related to the methods used at the project.
- The Project itself has to be submitted at latest two weeks before the Minor state exam into InSIS (application Coursework submission).
