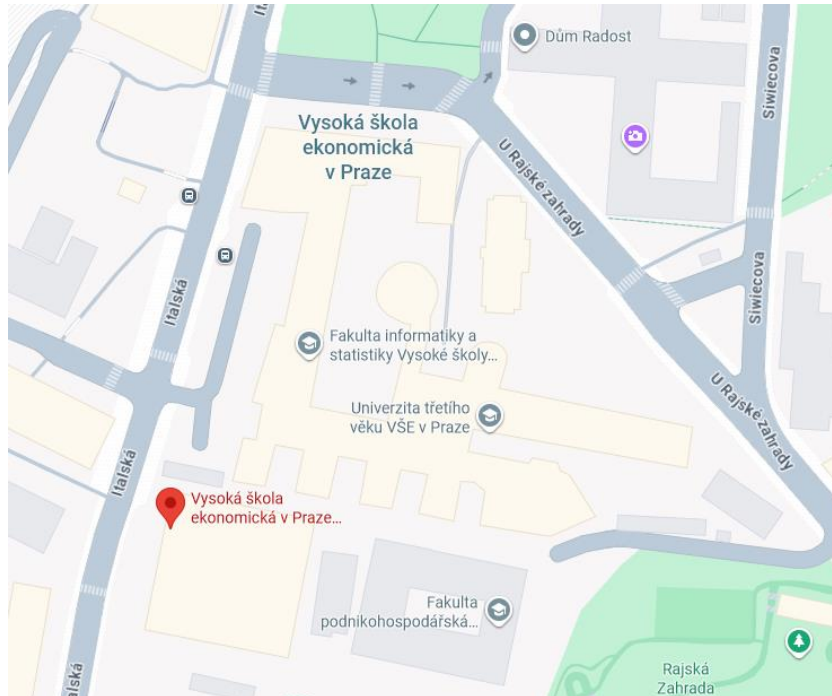


How to Enter the Italská Building (IB) at VŠE

1. Location:

The Italská building (IB) is part of the main VŠE Žižkov campus, located at [Italská 36, Prague 3](#). The entrance is from Italská street.



2. Entrance Procedure:

- The main entrance is clearly marked and located on the west side of the building, facing Italská street.
- Entrances to the Italian Building will **be freely accessible during graduation ceremonies**.

Here's a real photo of **the entrance to IB**:



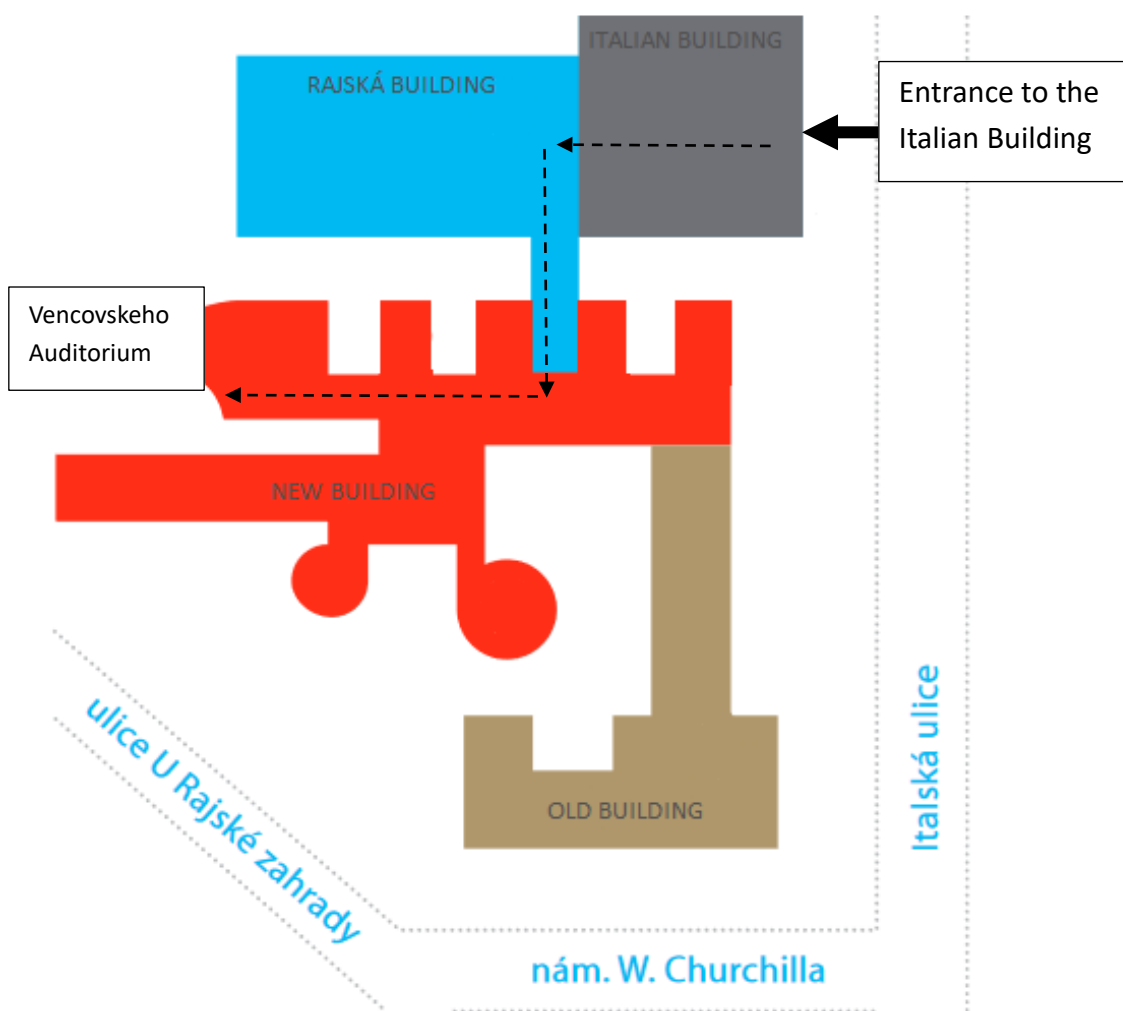
3. Campus Map:

- The Žižkov campus consists of four interconnected buildings: Old Building (SB), New Building (NB), Rajská Building (RB), and Italská Building (IB).

How to Get from the Italská Building Entrance to Vencovského Auditorium



1. Orientation:

- After entering the **Italská building (IB)**, you need to reach the **New Building (NB)**, where [the Vencovského Auditorium](#) is located.

2. Directions for Guests (family, friends etc.):

- From the main entrance of IB, proceed **straight ahead** and follow the signs to the New Building (NB).
- Continue straight ahead until you come to **a staircase on your left**, just behind the café. If you need to, you can use the elevator, which is right next to the staircase in the corner.
- **Go down the stairs** and **keep going straight ahead**, with glass walls and ceiling on both sides and above your head, until you reach the end of the corridor.
- Now you are at the New Building (NB), on the ground floor (“přízemí”) and **turn right**.
- The Vencovského Auditorium (“Vencovského aula”) is located **in front of you**. Just go to the end of the corridor.

3. Only for **Graduating students**:

- Graduates should **arrive 45 minutes before the commencement ceremony in the foyer** of the Vencovský Auditorium, located on **the first floor of the New Building**, where they will sign the graduation book and receive instructions regarding the ceremony.
